

# Kiss Me Good Night, playing with 'trash/scrap' fabric to make Improv blocks with Pat Sloan!

From blocks to the "Goodnight Kiss", use your fabric scraps in innovative ways! Pat will show you multiple ways to piece your 'trash' and turn them into FREE quilts! Or how about those swap blocks you never used? Maybe they didn't look great together, maybe they were different sizes or you didn't have enough of them. Bring them to class and learn how to Kiss this project DONE!

## Let's go to the Improv!

- Learn to make improv blocks
- Make Trash Bag Fabric – focus on fabric scraps
- Taking blocks you already own and making them sing
- Create "Kiss" blocks to set into a quilt.
- Turn your stash into FREE quilts!

## What are we really doing?

You will create some base improvisational blocks using scraps and other fabric. Learn about color and what will work and not work.

## Fabric

- Bring any misc block sets you own from swaps and such, will add them to the mix.
- At least 1 yard total of several black and white prints. Or bring a color you know you love, like the pink tone on tones for the pink kiss quilt. You won't set the blocks in class but you'll see how to use the accent to make the "Kiss" and I'll show you a "HUG" too!
- You will need a variety of fabrics. Trash/Scrap bag fabrics are great. Strips, chunks, bring it all Scraps work well for this.
- The more fabric you bring to choose from the better, I can get lots in a laundry basket!

## The Rest

- Sewing machine - remember your foot pedal :)
- Rotary Cutter, 12 x 6 or longer ruler, 12" square ruler and Mat.
- Sewing thread, scissors, pins, needles....
